Derek Pittman – UTSA

Lecture Title: Adapting Games, Training to Win

Derek Pittman enters his fourth season with UTSA after being hired on May 7, 2018 as the third head coach of the soccer program. He joined the Roadrunners after spending four seasons in the same capacity at the University of Idaho.

A native of Tulsa, Oklahoma, Pittman was a four-year starter and team captain for the University of Tulsa soccer program. He earned All-Missouri Valley Conference honors as a goalkeeper in 1995. Pittman went on to play professionally for the Barrow Amateur Football Club in Barrow, England, and the Columbus-Comets and Savannah RugRatz in the Eastern Indoor Soccer League.

He returned to Tulsa to complete his bachelor's degree in business administration in 1998. He then began his coaching career as a graduate assistant with the Golden Hurricane. He has additional coaching experience at the club level with the Pride Soccer Club of Missouri, the Tulsa Soccer Club and the Little Rock Futbol Club of Arkansas and is a United States Soccer Federation 'A' licensed coach.

I have been a teacher and soccer coach in the San Antonio area for over 17 years. Phil Duhon -Rockwall Heath

Lecture Title: Pressing and Defending

Phil Duhon is the head boys soccer coach at Rockwall-Heath High School, which he led to the State Championship Game in 2021, losing 0:2 to San Antonio LEE. The Hawks allowed a total of 3 goals during their 7-game playoff run. He was named the TASCO Region 2-6A Boys Coach of the Year as well as the Dallas Morning News All-Area Coach of the Year in 2021. He has been the head coach at Heath for the past 3 years, guiding them to the playoffs in each season. Prior to that, he was the head coach at Austin Westwood for 5 years, leading them to the playoffs in 2 of those

5 years, and he was named the Austin American-Statesman Boys Soccer Coach of the Year in 2014. Coach Duhon was a member of the LSU Track & Field team during his collegiate years. He has been married to Danielle for 24 years this October, and they have 3 daughters and a son and live happily in Heath, Texas.



Andy Holt - Frisco Wakeland

Lecture Title: Transitional Play

Coach Holt just finished his 19th year in education. This will be his 6th year as the Head Coach at Frisco Wakeland High School. Coach Holt has helped lead the Wolverines to four straight finals appearances, and winning the State Championship in 2017, 2018, and 2021. During his time at

Frisco Wakeland he has compiled a record of 105-12-15.

Before serving as the head coach at Wakeland, Holt was the head coach at Sulphur Springs High School for 14 years. The Wildcats advanced to the Regional Finals in 2006 and to the Regional Quarterfinals in 2013. Coach Holt finished at Sulphur Springs as the winningest soccer coach in the history of the program with a record of 217-96-52.

Coach Holt has been named the District Coach of the Year 8 times, the TASCO coach of the Year 2 times, and the Dallas Morning News Coach of the Year once. He has compiled an overall record of 322 wins, 108 losses, and 67 ties during his 19-year career as a head soccer coach.

Coach Holt is a 2002 graduate of the University of Mary Hardin-Baylor, where he played for the Crusaders. He is also a 1998 graduate of Sulphur Springs High School in Sulphur Springs, Texas. He currently teaches Geometry at Frisco Wakeland High School. He lives in Frisco with his wife, Lindsey, and their son Reese(15).

Bailee Perrine - Dripping Springs

Lecture Title: Pre-Season Preparedness

Bailee Perrine is the head coach of the Dripping Springs Women's Soccer team. During Perrine's four years as head coach, Dripping Springs has won the 5A State Championship, finished as State Semi-Finalists and before covid had a record of 21-1. Perrine has a 84.6% win percentage with an overall record of 88-14-2, with only two losses in the last two years. As an assistant, Bailee coached two years at College Station and one year at Westlake High School. In those three years, College Station finished as State Semi-Finalists twice and Westlake was Area Champions. Bailee is passionate about building a solid program from parent involvement to challenging her players' mindsets. Perrine's soccer program has grown from 26 athletes to 60 in four years. She focuses on individual experiences, and makes sure every player knows they are important and have a purpose in the program. Her athletes understand that there are high expectations, and everyone is held to that high standard.

Lecture Title: Finding Success as a New High School Coach

Michael Strong played soccer at Alamo Heights, for Bruce Fink, from 2000-2004. After playing at Alamo Heights he attended the University of Kentucky where he was a 4 year letterman. Following college it took him a while to find soccer again and in 2018 he got his first high school coaching job at Boerne High School as the boys soccer coach. In his first three years the team has won district all three years and this past season his team won the 4A State Championship. He was named All-State his junior and senior year, still holds the single season and career goal record at Alamo Heights, and in 2010 was named to UIL All-century Team, 1st team.
