

Superintendents,

UIL continues to work to provide schools as much flexibility as possible to reschedule varsity district contests postponed due to COVID-19 related reasons. UIL has worked closely with TEA to clarify what this flexibility may include.

The COVID-19 Pandemic has been identified as a 'public disaster' by the State of Texas. As long as we remain under this status as ordered by Governor Abbott, UIL varsity district contests postponed because of COVID-19 reasons may be rescheduled and played as exceptions to the school week limit as noted in state regulations, as long as they are rescheduled and played on a date agreed upon by the two schools involved in the contest, or on a date as determined by the District Executive Committee, if the two schools cannot agree.

This exception applies only to varsity district contests when the Governor's disaster declaration is in effect.
