From Little Dribblers to NCAA Division 1, Donna Capps is known for her coaching wins and country witticisms, Donna Capps' coaching career spans the high school (North Mesquite, Mabank, Crandall, and Horn) and college (University of Texas at Arlington) levels. Compiling an amazing 526/203 High School record and a 119/89 collegiate record, she is one of the most successful coaches in Texas high school girls' basketball history. The two-time Dallas Morning News Coach of the Year was also honored as the Dallas Times Herald Coach of the Year. During her career she earned High School Women's Coach of the Year honors by the Texas Association of Basketball Coaches, Texas Girls Coaches Association and Baden Sports Inc. As Head coach of UT Arlington, she was named the Southland Conference Coach of the Year, turning a struggling team into a NCAA Tournament contender (2005 & 2007). She is currently the Assistant Athletic Director for Mesquite ISD. Donna resides in Crandall, TX with her husband, Jon. She has 2 grown children and five grandchildren.

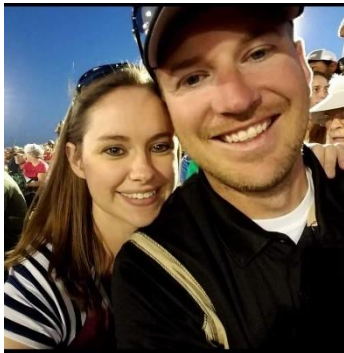
Lecture Title: *Building a Football Foundation*

As a head coach he built successful programs at Frenship, Cisco, EP Socorro, Llano and Midland Lee. He experienced success at the very highest levels winning three 5-A State Championships and a USA Today National Championship. He has spent the last 17 years at Boerne High School where he is the head boys' basketball coach, assists with football, and teaches American Government and Economics. Coach McHone graduated from Texas A&M University in 1990 with a degree in Kinesiology. Before coaching in Boerne, he coached at Uvalde High School and Snook High School. On December 5th of 2020 he won his 400th

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career game. He now has recorded 450 wins. His teams at Boerne High School have won, or shared, nine district championships, eleven area championships, advanced to the regional tournament four times (2010, 2018, 2020 and 2021), and advanced to the State Semifinals this past year. Coach McHone is the son of former San Antonio Spurs Head Coach, Mo McHone. He is married to Kari, who is a first-grade teacher in Boerne ISD. He and Kari have two children.
